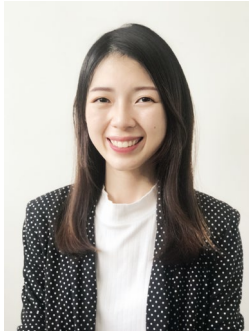


Dr Vivien Lee
